

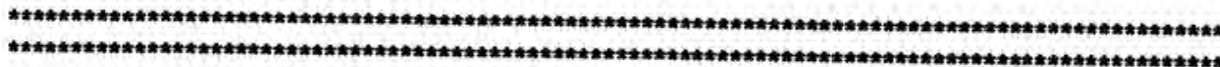

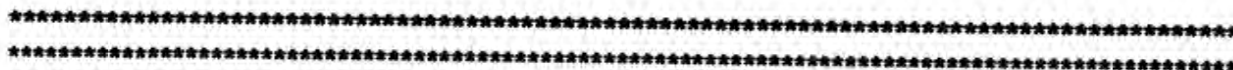

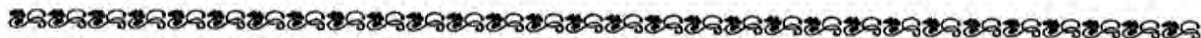


In September the Lodge will follow the summer schedule of 2 to 4pm on the 2nd & 4th
